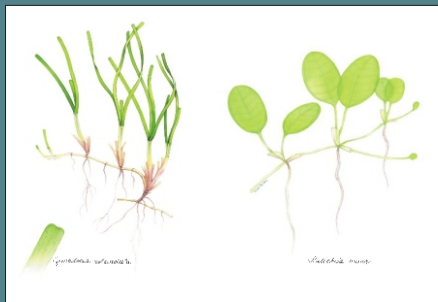
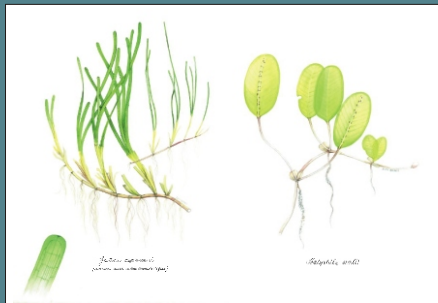
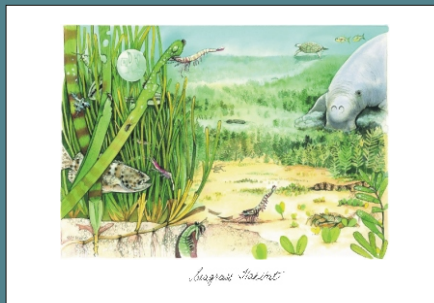

The Marine Plant Ecology Group researches seagrasses of Queensland to protect their fisheries values
Projects include:



Ensuring areas of seagrass critical to fisheries productivity in Queensland are identified and suitably managed

Monitoring the health and status of seagrasses, and other marine plants in ports and near shipping lanes



Monitoring changes in seagrass populations in areas set aside as Dugong Protection Areas

Working with coastal volunteer communities to develop local "Seagrass-Watch" expertise



Advising of the impact on seagrasses of coastal developments

Investigating the productivity of seagrasses and nutrient levels



Establishing a seagrass monitoring network program in the Western Pacific to monitor global scale environmental changes

A unique set of scientifically accurate paintings, including different forms and leaf tips to aid identification, in a style to reflect their value as part of Queensland's botanical heritage.

Seagrasses are a major component of coastal ecosystems, underpinning the productivity that supports recreational and commercial fisheries. Research and monitoring of these habitats is supported by the Queensland Department of Primary Industries and the CRC Reef Research Centre. Purchase of the artwork supports ongoing research.
